Speaker Presentation

The invited speaker was Jimmy Jacobs Editor of the Newsletter: On The Fly South and Polly Dean, Associate Editor. His contact information is jimmyjacobs@ontheflysouth.com and cell 678-849-5873. Members can subscribe to his free newsletter by going to the web site www.ontheflysouth.com A selection of his slides are attached. He discussed good fishing spots and recommended guides in each area. He recommended an intermediate line in many saltwater fishing situations because it prevents the line from being overcome by the waves, causing the fly to act erratically enticingly. He suggests a 9wt rod and six foot leader.

He has fished numerous places close to Southport he recommends for excellent fishing. Among them are:

- Georgetown/Winyah Bay, SC- Jimmy recommends Capt. Tommy Scarborough of Georgetown Coastal Adventures, the Murrell's Inlet Fishing Lodge and Perry's Bait Bucket
- Charleston, SC- He likes the Folly Beach area with its marsh and Capt. Ben Young of Charleston Lowcountry Guide Service former Coast Guard
- Fort Sumter, Charleston, SC- In the Charleston Bay, noted for Jack Crevalle
- **St. Simon Island, Sound & Goulds Inlet, GA** Capt. David Edens is an Orvis approved guide. Mullet Village and Murph's Tavern are worth the trip
- Hutchinson Island, southeast Florida Snook from the shore
- Cape Fear Region- Wilmington author and angler Mike Marsh knows it all about fishing in our area.
