SPEAKER PRESENTATION

Capt. Will Stephens presented in person about fly fishing opportunities in Brazil.

Will has been fly fishing for over 25 years and logged thousands of miles in Africa, Latin America and the Caribbean, the challenge was always being finding far flung places untouched by anglers with a focus on the elusive, the largest and hard to catch. Along the way, a natural appreciation for the environment and the cultures of people around the world always factored into finding the next best place to fish. Will currently resides in the South Carolina Low Country where he bought and since sold Southern Drawl Outfitters, a vintage fly and tackle shop supplying the communities surrounding Hilton Head Island.

Will works with Untamed Angling in Brazil which has access to 600 miles of river. They offer a week fishing trip for 12 anglers at a time. They cover the Amazon region and have exclusive rights to four lodges in Brazil and five lodges in Argentina. September to November are peak times, August to February are available.

You are required to bring your own gear; rods, reels, and flies. You can preorder flies with them.
